**DISTRICT 7 WOOL & MOHAIR JUDGING CONTEST  
GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**AGE DIVISIONS**

The following contestant ages are as of August 31, 2016:

- JUNIOR – age 8 and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade
- SENIOR –9<sup>th</sup> grade- 12<sup>th</sup> grade (contestant must not have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before August 31)

**FEES**

- \$5 per contestant
- \$5 late registration fee
- No refunds

**ENTRIES**

Any individual/team not registered that show up to contest will not be allowed to compete.

**Agents/Leaders must designate their team as either Wool or Mohair prior to the contest. They are welcome to participate in both, but can only qualify for state and/or received awards in one event.**

**There will be NO REFUNDS for teams/individuals that don't show up to the contest. If you miss the registration deadline you will be required to pay the late registration fee.**

Any number of teams may enter the contest, the top three (3) senior teams will advance to State Roundup. Therefore, all members of each team must be decided upon before the contest and maintained throughout the contest.

Teams will consist of three (3) or four (4) members. The scores of the three (3) highest scoring team members will count as the team's score with the low scoring member automatically becoming the alternate. Alternates and individual scores can be counted for individual awards.

- 5:00 PM Contest Begins

**CLASSES**

**Mohair**

Two (2) classes of four (4) fleeces each will be placed and reasons checked. Twenty mohair samples will be evaluated for fineness.

**Wool**

Judge two (2) classes of wool and complete an evaluation form on each. Evaluate 20 fleeces for grade, staple length and yield

**AWARDS**

- Determined by contest officials.
