## DISTRICT 7 RANGE EVALUATION CONTEST GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS

## **AGE DIVISIONS**

The following contestant ages are as of **August 31, 2020**:

- JUNIOR minimum age 8 and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade- 5<sup>th</sup> grade
- INTERMEDIATE grades 6<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup>
- SENIOR –grades 9<sup>th-</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> (Maximum age- 18 as of August 31, 2020)

### FEES - ALL MUST REGISTER ON 4-H Online

• \$10 per contestant

All contestants must be entered on 4-H Online.

There will be NO REFUNDS for teams/individuals that don't show up to the contest. If you miss the registration deadline you will be required to pay the late registration fee.

#### **ENTRIES**

The District 7 Range Evaluation, and Pasture Plant ID Contests will be held in conjunction with the Eldorado-Divide Soil & Water Conservation District Contest.

Range Evaluation and Pasture Plant ID are now invitational at Texas 4-H Roundup.

Teams will consist of three (3) or four (4) members. The scores of the three (3) highest scoring team members will count as the team's score with the low scoring member automatically becoming the alternate. Alternates and individual scores can be counted for individual awards.
