DISTRICT 7 4-H HORSE SHOW GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS

AGE REQUIREMENTS

The following contestant ages are as of August 31, 2021:

• Age 8 and in the 3rd grade to the 12th grade (Maximum age- 18 as of August 31st)

AGE DIVISIONS

- 3rd 8th grade: Juniors
- 8th-12th grade: Seniors

DISTRICT ENTRY FEES

• Qualifying Events \$15.00 per class

(2-Year-old & 3-Year old Futurity \$20 per division)

• Open/Invitational Events \$15.00 per class

STALLING, BEDDING, TRAILER HOOKUPS

The following items are available at the San Angelo Fair Grounds. Participants will be responsible for getting these items the day of the show or you may call the Stock Show Office 325-653-7785 for more information. <u>We will NOT collect in advance for these fees.</u>

- Horse Stalls \$20.00 per stall Required for stalling a horse for any length of time
- Bedding \$ 10.00 per bag
- Trailer Hookups \$30.00 per day for 30 amp hook up/ \$30 per day for 50 amp hook up (limited number)

<u>RULES</u>

The District 7 Horse Show will be conducted according to the official rules of the Texas 4-H Horse Show, plus additional stipulations outlined in these rules. Review the State Rules with your exhibitors. New State rule revisions are highlighted with red, made as per State 4-H Horse Committee recommendations. The judge's ruling is final for results and rule interpretation.

Horses must be validated by May 1. Horses not validated on or before May 1 are ineligible for District and State Horse Shows.

The current Texas Animal Health Commission regulation states that all equine must have a negative test for EIA conducted within the previous 12 months. This will include both the District 7 4-H Horse Show and Texas 4-H Horse Show.

ENTRIES

Entries will be submitted online via 4- ONLINE REGISTRATION by the deadline.

State Horse Show entries will be completed on 4-H Connect.

Members can sign up for State Horse Show <u>but agents will not approve them until after the District Horse Show is</u> <u>over.</u>

Contestant Registration Steps:

- 4-H Online Web Address: <u>https://texas.4honline.com/</u>
- Create a profile and family e-mail address in the 4-H Online registration program if you do not have one already established. If you do not have a profile established, the county office will have to accept you as a member before you can move on to the next step.
- Find "Register A Member In An Event" section, select the member's name, then select: "D7 Horse Show-2021".
- Make your event selections.
- Fill out entry forms that can be downloaded from 4-H Connect. Forms must be typed and printed front & back if possible. In order to fill out the form properly, you must first download the form to your desktop and save it. At that point you should have no difficulty filling it out.
- Submit payment online.
