A note from the nurse.

We are so excited to have your child at camp in the next few weeks. Please feel free to call me with any questions or health concerns. Just a few reminders from the handbook and health statement.

**Insurance Cards:** Please remember to send a physical copy of the front and back of your child's insurance card to camp with them.

## **Medications:**

- Must be in the original container.
- Must have your child's name on the prescription label of the medication.
- All prescribed medication must have a pharmacy label (this includes epi pens and inhalers)
- We can only administer medications as directed on the prescription label. So if your child is taking it in a different fashion such as 1 pill instead of 2 or in the morning instead of at night, please have your physician write a note directing us how to administer the medication.
- List medication your child will be taking on Section IV of the health statement as this is your authorization allowing us to administer the medication.

## **Physician orders:**

- If your child has any heart related problems, we will need a physician release for activity
- We will need physician orders if you child has a chronic condition such as Type 1 Diabetes

## Camp Check In:
